Instructions



Supplies Needed:

Copies of worksheets in this packet.

Also:

Thin black markers You choice of color media, such as crayons and watercolors. A lesson about using warm and cool colors.

VOCAB WORDS

WARM COLORS - Colors that remind you of fire, such as red, orange, and yellow. Brown and tan are also warm colors.

COOL COLORS - Colors that remind you of night or winter, such as blue, purple and green. Cool gray is also a cool color.



LESSON 1: THE COLOR WHEEL

Pre-assess students using the hot dog and cool cat presassessment.

Introduce students to the color wheel and show them how they can understand color mixing by using the color wheel. Have them fill in the colors of the color wheel by using only the primary colors to mix the secondary colors.





LESSOU 2: WARM AND COOL COLORS


Introduce students to the concept of warm and cool colors. Ask students to name things that feel warm and cool or remind them of feeling warm or cool. Point out that many of the things they mention also have warm and cool colors. Show them how the color wheel can me divided into 2 sides; the warm colors and the cool colors. Have them fill out the warm and cool color wheel and add some of their favorite warm and cool colors that are not on the color wheel (Like pink, turquoise, gold, and lime green).



Let them get started coloring the dogs with warm colors and the cats with cool colors on the "Hot Dogs and Cool Cats" coloring page. (This can be something they come back and work on any time they finish early during the next couple of lessons.)








Can you make the secondary colors orange, green and violet by mixing the right primary colors?
